

Check out various year-round Santa Claus theme parks such as:

- Holiday World in Santa Claus, Indiana (Yes, there is actually a town named Santa Claus.)
- Santa's Village Amusement and Water Park, East Dundee, IL
- Santa's Village in Lake Arrowhead, California
- North Pole – Santa's Workshop at the base of Pikes Peak in Colorado Springs, CO
- Santa's Land in Putney, VT (reopened in 2017)
- Santa's Village in Jefferson, NH
- Santa's Workshop in Wilmington, New York
- North Pole, Alaska – The Santa Claus House has a Santa for most of the year
- Castle Noel in Medina, Ohio (known as the “largest year-round indoor Christmas entertainment attraction”)

Not to mention seasonal offerings during the year like these:

- Santa's Land Fun Park and Zoo in Cherokee, NC (Open May - October)
- Jingle Kansas City at the Legends Outlets in Kansas City, KS
- The North Pole Experience in Flagstaff, AZ

Think of all the seasonal “**North Pole Express**” trains that run during the season. There are literally dozens (I counted 40 in the U.S.) of these that run from Chehalis, WA in the far northwest to Burlington, VT in the northeast, and from Stettler, Alberta, Canada in the north to Miami, FL in the south.
